- Manages the staffing of KCUK radio
- Oversees the finances (grants, funding, donations) of KCUK with the support of KSD Chief Financial Officer
- Complies with the rules and regulations of all funding sources in reporting policies and financial reports
- Collaborates with public media affiliates like CPB, Native Public Media, CoastAlaska, National Public Radio, Kohanic Corporation, Native Voice 1, Alaska Broadcasters Association.
- Work with local organizations such as the Public Safety, Search and Rescue, the Chevak Tribe and villages within the KCUK radio service to produce community service programs, and Public Service Announcements

- Solicit corporate businesses, local organizations, the City of Chevak and Tribal Council and tribal affiliates for donations and fundraising
- Maintain national and statewide emergency alert system for public safety and search and rescue
- Provide basic radio broadcasting and production classes for high school students
- Work with KSD teachers and their students with radio education productions
- Work with Cup'ik/Yup'ik immersion language programs
